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# 1. Victims of Crime

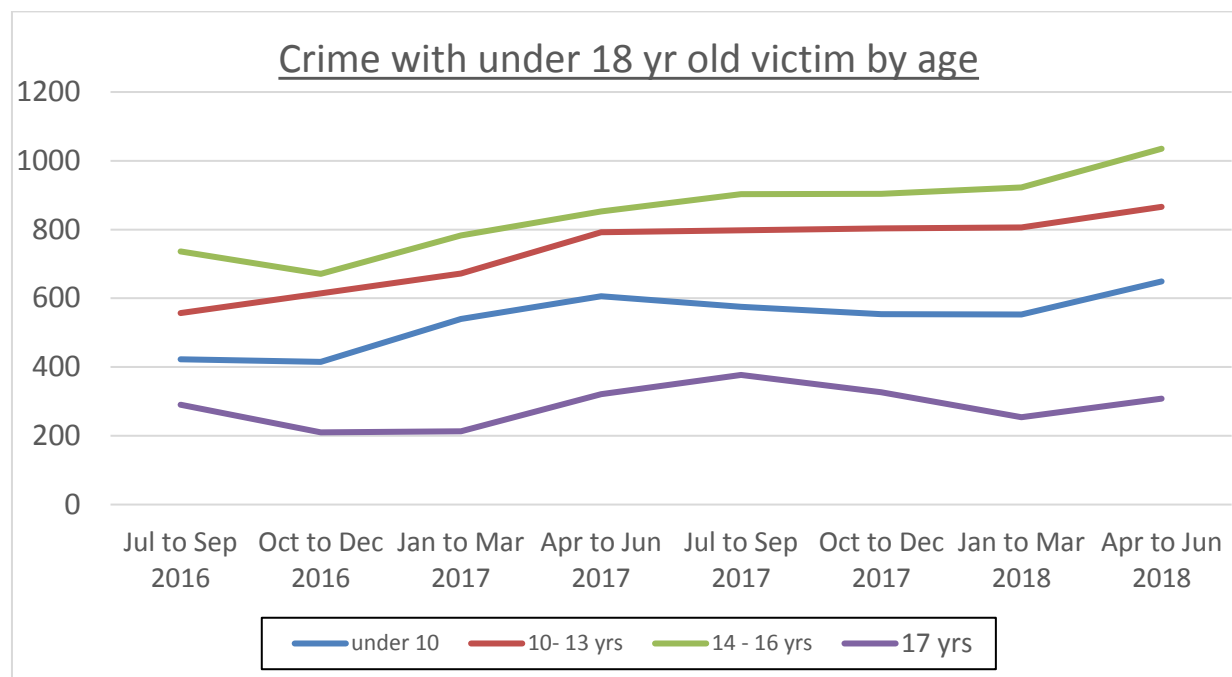

### Comments/summary

The 11% increase in crimes with victims under 18 yr old is a slightly higher increase than all crimes for all ages which is 7% rise. The increases in violence with and without injury of 18% and 21% respectively are similar to those for same offence group for all ages (up 14% and up 22%).

Offences of rape and other sexual offences for victims under 18 yr old are 44% and 63% respectively of these offence types for all ages.

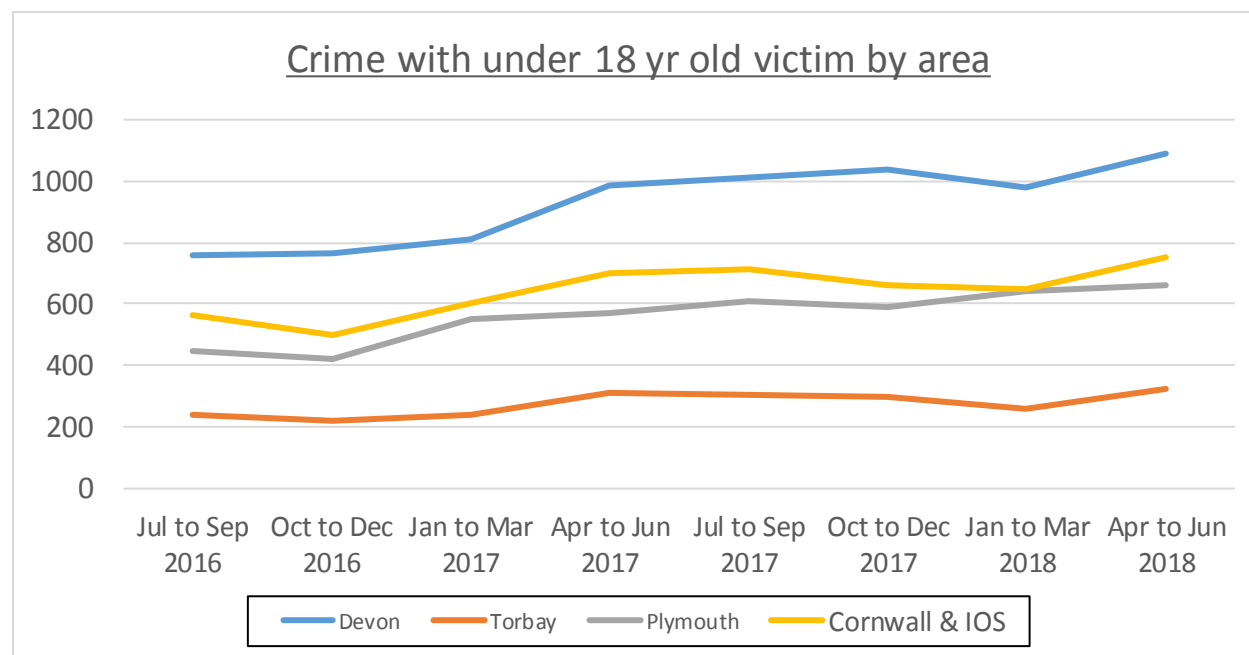
The trend over the 2 years in the graph above shows that all 4 age groups have had increases. For all crimes with under 18 yr old victims the level has gone from 1,910 for quarter Oct to Dec 2016 up to 2,858 in quarter April to June 2018. All under 18 yr age groups increased in 12 months to June 2018 (see above table) against all age increase of 17%.

The focus on crime recording with all officers trained and robust monitoring in place during 2017 and 2018 has contributed to the rise in crimes recorded to give more accurate picture.

### Comments/summary

For this quarter each area has had an increase in under 18 yrs victims, the increase varies from 5% to 17%, compared to all ages increase of 7%.

Looking longer term, crimes with under 18 yrs victims have risen by 22% for 12 months to June 2018 compared to 12 months to June 2017. This rise varies across LA areas (Torbay and Cornwall at 18% up, then Devon 24% up and then Plymouth at 26% up).

### Comments/Summary

- The 32 other offender outcomes in April to June 2018 were 22 TICs, 5 cannabis warnings and 5 adult simple cautions.
- 33% of outcome 21s were for sexting offences with 25% for violence related offences
- There was one outcome 21 for an 8 yr old for an ABH offence
  
- Of the 77 outcomes for under 10 yr olds, 6 were for under 6 yr olds - 2 for rape and 4 for sexual offences. 15 were sexual offences for 6 to 9 yr olds.

Of the 114 sexting offences, 77 had outcome 21, 3 had charge/postal requisition, 1 adult simple caution and 33 NFAs.

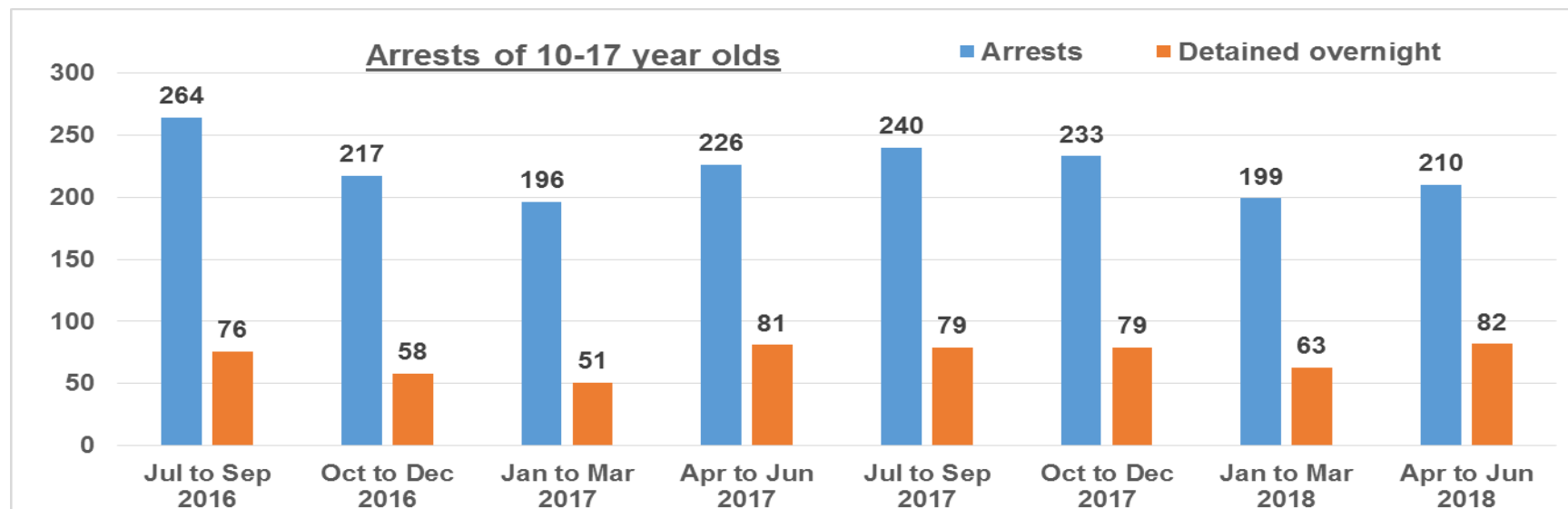

#### Comments/summary

Arrest levels have seasonal pattern with July to Sept 2016 and 2017 higher than other quarters. The % detained overnight was higher in April to June 2018 quarter than for previous quarters back to July 2016 (39%), with lowest % being in Jan to March 2017 quarter (26%).

Time spent in custody has seen changes on previous year with lower % of arrests for time less than 8 hours. Time spent of 8 to 20 hours has increased but time spent over 20 hours has reduced from 14% to 9%.

Detentions of 10 to 13 yr olds was 9 with no detention not authorised. There were 8 detentions not authorised – 6 x 14-16 yr olds and 2 x 17 yr olds.

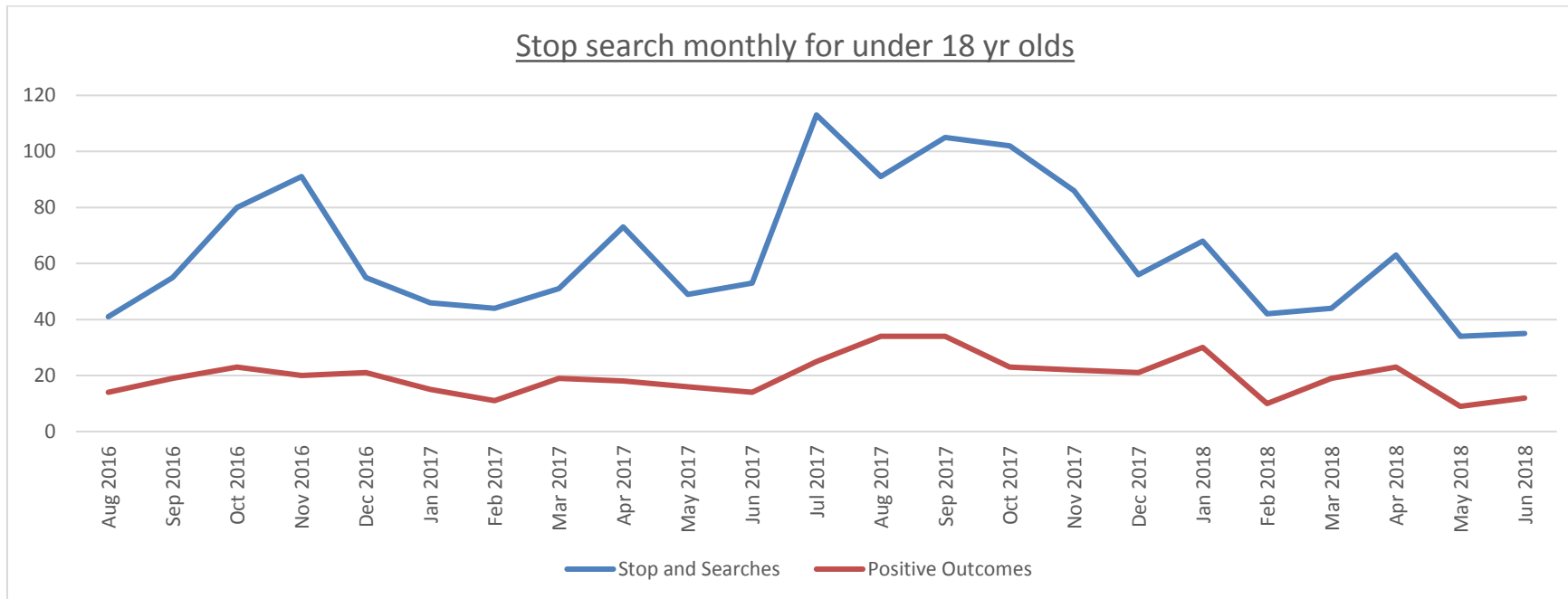
## 6.8 Stop and Search reason for arrest by age (not available as issue with data)

### Comments/summary

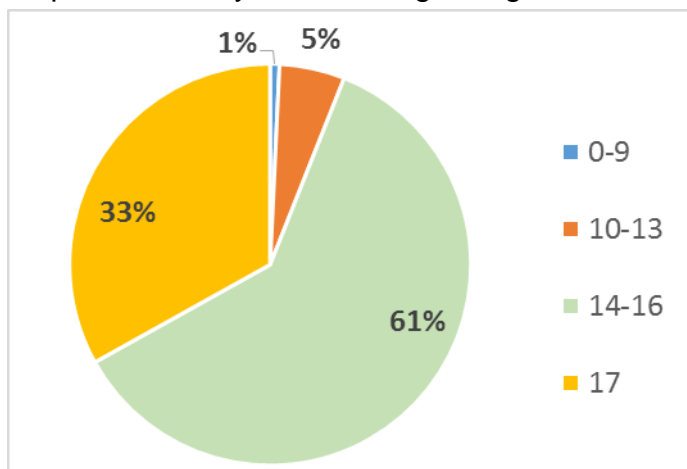
